These outings promote confidence, independence, and social engagement. Occasionally, participants join other Nexus day programs for larger community events, helping strengthen connections beyond our centers.

Referral & Enrollment Process

Schedule a Tour

Reach out to our Client Services Manager to schedule a visit, ask questions, and learn more about our services and eligibility requirements.

Connect with Your FNRC Service Coordinator

Speak with your Far Northern Regional Center (FNRC) Service Coordinator about joining our program. They will submit a referral to WTC on your behalf.

Referral Review

Our team carefully reviews each referral to ensure a strong match between the program and your individual needs.

Enrollment Requirements *To participate, individuals must:*

- Be 18 years or older
- Have independent mobility (ambulatory)
- Manage personal daily activities (ADLs) without assistance
- Self-administer necessary medications during the program day
- Function well in group settings with a 1:4 staff ratio
- Be able to engage safely in the program environment.
- Commit to attending program regularly
